

# Proofing / editing checklist

**Allow time to both revise and edit**

**First check:** structure, logic and sense

**Second check:** detail: spelling, punctuation, grammar

**Third check:** out loud, back to front, by someone else...

*Or Fast, slow, then backwards.*

## Revising

*Considering what you are saying as a whole, and where you are saying it.*

- Have I been utterly truthful?
- Have I said all that I need to say?
- Have I been appropriately diplomatic and fair?
- Is anything essential missing?
- Are important points stressed?

## Editing

*Fine tuning the sentences and paragraphs.*

- Do I have three parts to the piece: an opener, a middle and a closer?
- In my opener, have I made my points quickly and clearly?
- Have I avoided delaying the key message with a slow wind up?
- In the middle, have I proved my points with specifics?
- Is the structure immediately apparent to my readers? Have I used informative headings? Are my transitions smooth?
- Is my closer clear and non-repetitive?
- Is the meaning of each sentence clear and accurate?
- What can I trim (without removing important context)?
- Are there any vague passages I can sharpen?
- Are there any boring passages I can make more vivid?
- Can I improve the phrasing?
- Can I improve the punctuation?
- Are there any typos?
